



Making a bequest to the National Railway Museum Incorporated

Thank you for your support of the National Railway Museum Incorporated. Before you decide to make a bequest, especially a bequest of items, there are some steps to take.

In the first instance, please discuss your intentions with our Curator, who can determine if the National Railway Museum is the best location for your items. It is also worth considering gifting your items to the National Railway Museum as a donation now or in the near future, rather than as part of a bequest, as this gives the team the opportunity to speak to you about the collection, ask questions, and clarify information which provides a more complete history of your items.

If you would still like to gift items as a bequest, please also consider putting aside some funds to assist with the transport of these items to the National Railway Museum, as costs can be prohibitive.

Wording to discuss with your legal representative:

With regard to your gift, we recommend that you speak with your legal representative about inserting the following statement into your will:

"I GIVE, FREE OF ALL DUTIES AND TAXES
